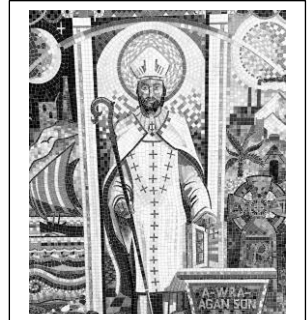

CELEBRATIONS

6th Sunday of Easter: Jesus urges his followers to keep his commandments and promises them the gift of the Holy Spirit. The same gift is offered to us. If we live in the Spirit, then the Spirit will live in us.

The Ascension of the Lord: The Gospel of Matthew which opened with the promise of ‘God with us’, ends with Jesus’ assurance that: ‘I am with you always, to the end of the age.’ This is a central tenant of our faith and is why this is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses are Wednesday evening at 6.30pm & Thursday at noon.

7th Sunday of Easter: Jesus entrusts to his Father those whom he has made his name known; and prays that they will be able to spread the Word throughout the world. This prayer of Jesus, is a prayer for us.

This Weekend: CAFOD Appeal for Sudan: Since April 2023, the conflict in Sudan has forced millions of people to flee their homes. Three years later, the conflict shows no sign of ending. It is the world’s largest humanitarian crisis, with over 33 million people (more than half of Sudan's population) in urgent need of humanitarian assistance like medical care, food and shelter.
