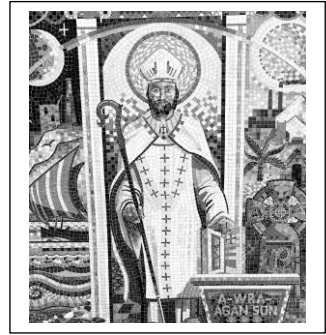

CELEBRATIONS

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time: God in his goodness, has cancelled out our debts. And when we ‘go into the red’ God waits for us to return; and forgives again. From this example, needs to flow our forgiveness for our brothers and sisters.

Sunday is ‘Education Day’ in the Church when we celebrate the achievements of our Catholic schools, teachers and catechists who work so hard to communicate our faith to others.

25th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Our Gospel today is a reminder to us about how God treats those who come to him. Equally. Whether it was people thousands of years ago in search of the Promised Land, or people today, people like us. Early arrivals or late, all are offered God’s overflowing goodness.

Today is also Evangelii Gaudium / Home Mission Sunday. Home Mission Sunday is a day to celebrate our faith in these lands, and an opportunity to renew our shared commitment to communicate the beauty and the joy of knowing Jesus Christ.
