## Our Lenten Parish Charity is Aid to the Church in Need

**AID TO THE CHURCH IN NEED** – Gaza's Christians have always been a tiny minority, numbering no more than 1,000 among a population of 2.3million. As fighting began, many Christians sought refuge in the compound of the Holy Family Catholic Church- which includes a convent and school - and the grounds of St Porphyrius' Greek Orthodox Church. The Holy Family's school took in over 500 refugees who fled their homes, with families sleeping in corridors and rooms. Since the outbreak of conflict on 7<sup>th</sup> October, these poor souls have been the sole responsibility of the Church, which is providing meals, water and medical care among other aid.
