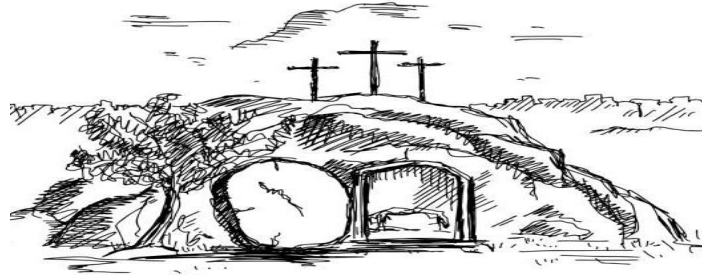

Sat 4th

THE EASTER VIGIL ~ 8pm

It is the great vigil. Easter brilliance lights up the night in which the feast of all feasts is celebrated. A cry of Good News echoes across time and space – Christ is risen! And following the vigil, drinks continue our celebrations.

Sun 5th

EASTER SUNDAY

8.30am: Mass. Followed by breakfast
10.30am: Mass. Followed by an Easter Egg hunt

Mon 6th

EASTER MONDAY

Readings: Acts 2:14.22-33; Matthew 28:8-15

The women who were the first witnesses of the risen Christ, rush to tell others. And Peter, who had once denied ever having known Jesus, now cannot stop proclaiming that Jesus is risen. They are all impelled to share their experience with others. Let us do the same.

Tues 7th

EASTER TUESDAY

Readings: Acts 2:36-41; John 20:11-18

‘Whom are you seeking?’ Jesus asks Mary, who doesn’t recognise him, until he calls her by name. Then, she truly sees him. And God calls each one of us. So, if we seek, we will see.

Wed 8th

EASTER WEDNESDAY

Readings: Acts 3:1-10; Luke 24:13-35

Jesus walks with us. We don’t always recognise him, but he is always with us if we look with the eyes of faith, most especially when we gather together to celebrate Mass.

EASTER THURSDAY

Readings: Acts 3:11-26; Luke 24:35-48

When we gather together at Mass, we gather around the risen Christ and enter into communion with him. Our minds have been opened to the Word.
